Town of Onoway By Election




On October 28th, 2019 Wade Neilson resigned from his position as Councillor for the Town of Onoway.

At the November 7th, 2019 Council meeting Council set the following:

Nomination will commence on Thursday, November 7th and close at 12 noon on Friday, December 13th, 2019. Nomination papers and candidate information can be found on our website or picked up at the Town office. Fully completed nomination papers can be dropped off at the Town office. Election day (if required) will be held on Friday, January 24th, 2020 voting to take place from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Town of Onoway Council Chambers. An advance vote will be held on Saturday, January 18th, 2020 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Town of Onoway Council Chambers. The successful candidate will serve until the October 2021 General Election. Separate enclosure will have additional information.

Snow Clearing

During the winter months, Public Works will be doing a combination of pushing the snow onto the boulevards and streets, and hauling the snow away. Public Works will be putting signage up in areas prior to major snow clearing asking people not to park on the street. Violators will be tagged and towed at their expense. Public Works also asks that people do not shovel their sidewalks onto the street after they have gone by with the equipment. When you see the equipment working please be patient and courteous and give them room to work.

FIRES CAN HAPPEN! ARE YOU COVERED!

Did you know that the cost of fire suppression by the fire department for structure, grass or vehicle fire is payable by the property owner? In our region, we have seen structure fires as high at \$28,000 and wildland fires as high as \$12,000.

- Be sure to check your home insurance policy or talk to your insurance agent about what exactly your policy covers and how much it covers
- Besides inquiry about your home structure fire insurance, we encourage you to have a conversation with respect to wildland insurance (a grass fire that could happen that never reaches a building).
- Be advised that should the fire department be dispatched to your residence as a result of a home alarm, a false alarm or, for example, a passerby sees smoke and calls 9-1-1, you, as the property owner, will receive an invoice for these call outs.
- If the fire department is dispatched to assist Alberta Health Services with respect to a medical call you will not be invoiced. This is a free service provided by North West Fire Rescue through Onoway Regional Fire Services.


