NOISE BYLAW 587-02

The Town of Onoway has a bylaw for the purpose of prohibiting, eliminating or abating noise. Some of the key points of this bylaw include:

Domestic noises – no person shall operate any powered equipment, including lawnmowers, snow blowers, garden tillers and built-in vacuum cleaners that are vented to the outside in a residential zone between the hours of:

- Ten o'clock in the evening and seven o'clock in the morning of the next day which is a week-day, or
- Eleven o'clock in the evening and eight o'clock in the morning of the next day which is a weekend or holiday.

Any person who owns, keeps, houses, harbours or allows to stay on his premises an animal which by reason of barking or howling, disturbs persons in the vicinity of their home is guilty of an offence under this bylaw.

OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES

The Town of Onoway has a bylaw to regulate and control the operation of "off-highway vehicles". Some of the key points of this bylaw are as follows:

- No resident of Onoway shall operate an off-highway vehicle in the Town except for the purpose of
 proceeding from his/her residence to permitted areas and back to his/her residence by the most direct
 route possible.
- When a person operates an off-highway vehicle in an alley, lane or on a highway, the operator shall travel at a rate of speed not in excess of 30km/h (18 mph) and obey all laws and regulations of the Town and the Province of Alberta.
- No off-highway vehicle shall be operated within the Town corporate limits between the hours of 11:00 p.m. of one day and 8:00 a.m. the following day.

PUBLIC WORKS


