**Important Notice  
Scheduled System Shutdown**

Dear: Municipal Stakeholders:

**Re: Notice of Planned System Shutdown Impacting Your Community**

The Capital Region Water system requires a scheduled shutdown to complete a system upgrade on their line. As a result of this, the WILD Water Commission will not be able to fill reservoirs from **0600 hrs Wednesday January 27, 2021 through to approximately 1600 hrs Friday January 29, 2021.**

All communities are asked to ensure their reservoirs are completely full prior to the start of the shutdown. We also recommend that you notify your users to conserve water during this time to ensure your water supply lasts the duration of the shutdown and essential or emergency services are spared any undue impacts.

The Capital Region water system will have limited storage of water and limited pumping capabilities during this shutdown, in an urgent situation we will be able to get limited flows and volumes from them. This access will be prioritized for urgent and emergency situations.

For the duration of this shutdown, the bulk water fill stations will be out of service to ensure that the WILD system is ready to fill all communities as soon as the shutdown is completed. Once the community reservoirs are topped up the bulk water fill stations will be reopened.

We apologize for the inconvenience and ask that you share this important message with your residents and community stakeholders as soon as possible. Our operations team will be in touch to let your community know once the system is back to full operation.
