Title:	Pride Flag Crosswalk

BACKGROUND / PROPOSAL

At the meeting of June 8, 2023, Council passed the following motion:

Motion #189/23 - MOVED by Deputy Mayor Lisa Johnson that Council accept the information presented on crosswalk design and installation.

CARRIED

At this time, Public Works is requesting that the Pride flag that was originally painted on the crosswalk at the Hub to Centennial Park be moved to the sidewalk.

DISCUSSION / OPTIONS / BENEFITS / DISADVANTAGES

Benefits for this move are:

- Smaller surface area.
- Maintenance and application are less as there is less foot traffic than there is road traffic.
- Cost are kept low on paint as there is not as much needed to reapply year after year.
- The success of the Aboriginal sidewalk at the community hall proves that it will hold up longer and will stay vibrant and colourful.

The contract for the crosswalk that was painted was not paid in full. Administration did approve partial payment for labour.
