MESSAGE FROM MAYOR LENARD KWASNY

CAO Thompson and I attended the Alberta Municipalities Leadership Caucus held in Edmonton on March 14 and 15. There was a lot of opportunity for networking and sharing ideas of what is working and not working in our municipalities. Amazing enough almost every municipality is facing similar challenges as we are: lack of funding for infrastructure upgrading; maintaining doctors in smaller communities; the negativity that is being shared on social media; and the list goes on.

Also, CAO Thompson and I attended The State of The Region dinner at Stony Plain where the Town of Stony Plain, City of Spruce Grove, and Parkland County share their past years' accomplishments as well as this year's goals. It is so great to see 3 municipalities working together to accomplish the needs of their community.

The Towns financial audit has been completed and will be presented at the April 11 Council meeting.

The Town will be making changes in the fire service provider within the next year. Updates will be provided as they become available.

At our last council meeting of March 28, our Economic Development and Tourism Committee Chaiman Dale Johnson submitted his resignation to Council. I would like to thank Dale for the work he has done to date. The ED&T Committee will continue to compile its team and move forward.

Lemonade Day is once again a go, scheduled for the same weekend as Heritage Days (June 15, 2024). This is where you get to meet these budding junior entrepreneurs. They will greatly appreciate your support.

The Town of Onoway has approved the terms of reference for the beautification committee and will be looking for volunteers, so if you have a green thumb and are interested information will be out shortly.

April is shaping up to be another busy month with meeting, workshops and planning for the summer months.




Council has approved a recommendation from the Onoway Economic Development and Tourism Committee to provide up to \$1000.00 per commercial property owner to refresh your storefront.
