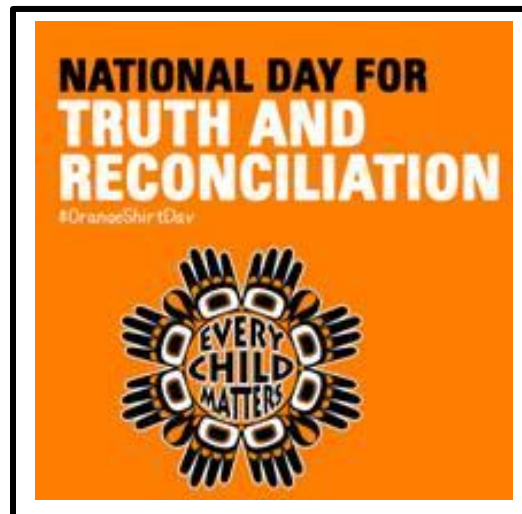

This is a large scale project. It will take us a few months to get your community connected and installed for service.

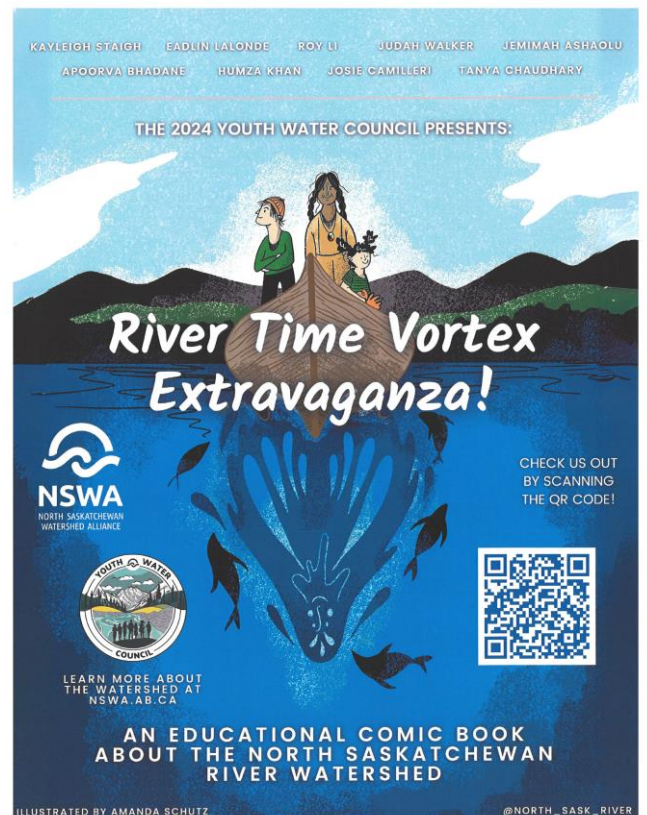
