Council has implemented the Non-Residential Tax Incentive program to allow businesses an opportunity to expand or develop new businesses. Check out the Onoway website <u>www.onoway.ca</u> for details.

As of March 8, 2025, the Town of Onoway's fire services will be provided by Lac Ste Anne County Fire Services. A five-year agreement has been signed with LSACFS.

I would like to thank Fire Rescue International for the service they provided the Town of Onoway for the last 9 years.

Administration is in the process of the 2024 audit and it is expected to be completed by the end of March.

It is the season where all the potholes appear mysteriously, not only in our town but in all town roads and highways. The freeze/thaw cycle was hard on our roads. Our Public Works staff have started patching.

On March 1, the Town of Onoway sponsored the Veterans Table at the Royal Canadian Legion Onoway. The Legion has also extended their recognition to include emergency response services such as Fire, Ambulance and Police.




