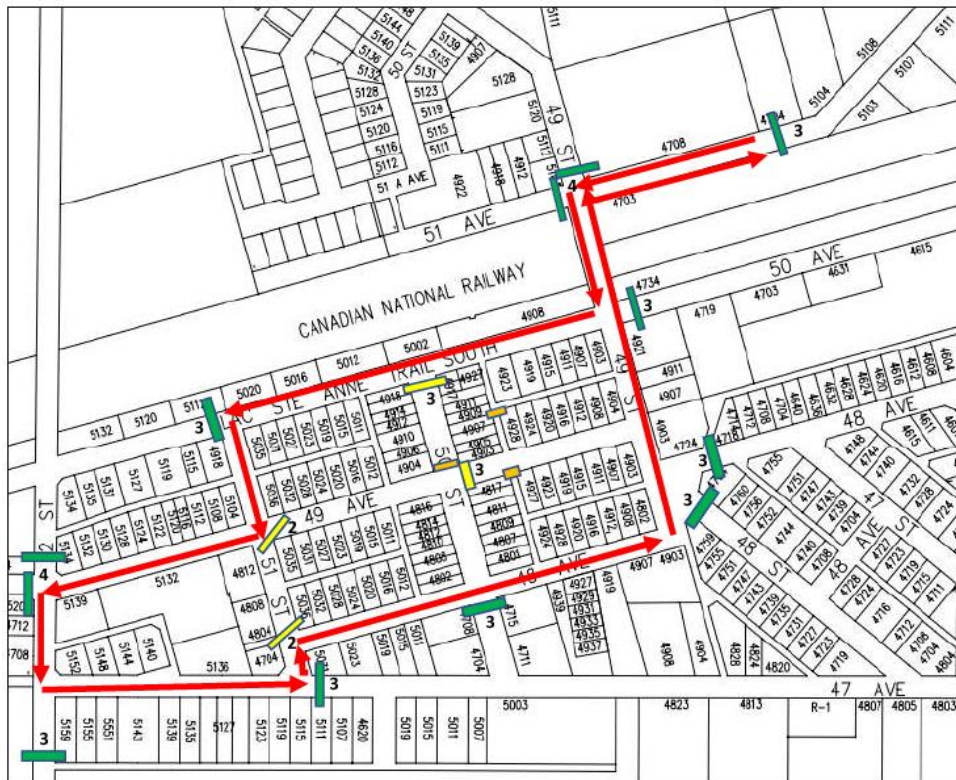
Heritage Days Downtown Layout/Locations (as of 29 May 2025)
