This charge will no longer be on the utility billing that residents receive in August.

The 2025 operating budget was passed with a 7.67% increase in municipal base tax dollars collected (of which 3.89%-Amortization & (0.96%)-Expenses & 2.82%-Reserves). (The 2024 budget was passed with a 3.88% increase.)
