The bins will be located at the Public Works yard at 5104-41 Street for people to drop off large items that would not normally be picked up on regular waste collection days. These items are:

Metals – stoves, refrigerators, other appliances.

Wood – including long tree branches, construction materials, etc.

NOTE: Residents will need to take WOOD to the Town's Lagoon Site.

Waste – mattresses, chairs and other large items.

Electronics – T.V., microwaves, etc.


Wire – fencing, electrical wire, etc.
