A BYLAW TO CONTROL LAND USE.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, Sections 633 and 692(1) of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, a municipality may amend an adopted Land Use Bylaw.


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Onoway has determined it necessary to amend the Town of Onoway Land Use Bylaw No. 712-13 as a means to promote effective and efficient land use within the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the lands legally known as Plan 4114 TR, Block A be re-districted from Residential Single Family District (R1) to Residential Single Family Narrow Lot District (R1N) in accordance with attached Schedule "A".

2. That this Bylaw comes into full force and effect upon third and final reading.
