VILLAGE OF ONOWAY By-law 637-05

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ONOWAY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE TO AMEND BYLAW 520-98, BEING THE LAND USE BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ONOWAY

WHEREAS, Section 639 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, 2000 and any amendment thereto provides that a Council of a Municipality must pass a bylaw for Land Use.

AND WHEREAS, in order to allow greater flexibility for the Development Authority and the Municipal Planning Commission to grant setback variances within the municipality, Council wishes to remove sections placing a 10% limitation on the variance powers of the Development Authority and of the Municipal Planning Commission to relax rear yard setbacks on parcels located on curves or cul-de-sacs in the R1-Residential-Single Family, R2-Residential-Medium Density and RMHS-Residential-Mobile Home Subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Onoway, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw 520-98 be amended by deleting the following sections:

114(5)(c)(ii)

115(5)(c)(ii)

117(5)(g)

That this Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.
