

**BY-LAW NO. 560-01**  
**VILLAGE OF ONOWAY**

**Being A Bylaw Of The Village Of Onoway, In The Province Of Alberta, To  
Provide for solid waste collection and recycling for the Village of Onoway.**

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Statutes of Alberta 1994, provides that a municipality may pass a bylaw to provide for services supplied by the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** it is desirable, in the public interest, to provide for the orderly operation of a waste removal and recycling service for the municipality;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** That the Village of Onoway Council, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and the Municipal Manager be authorized to sign an agreement with Stand-Stone Waste Services to provide solid waste collection and hauling from Village of Onoway residences, and accumulation of recyclable materials at their shop location.
2. The term of this agreement is to be seven (7) years, with an option to renew of a further three (3) years.
3. The Contract is to be forwarded to Alberta Energy and Utilities Board for approval prior to execution as required by Section 45, M.G.A.
4. The contract forms Schedule "A" of this bylaw.

This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.
