BY-LAW NO. 560-01 VILLAGE OF ONOWAY

Being A Bylaw Of The Village Of Onoway, In The Province Of Alberta, To Provide for solid waste collection and recycling for the Village of Onoway.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Statues of Alberta 1994, provides that a municipality may pass a bylaw to provide for services supplied by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable, in the public interest, to provide for the orderly operation of a waste removal and recycling service for the municipality;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That the Village of Onoway Council, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and the Municipal Manager be authorized to sign an agreement with Stand-Stone Waste Services to provide solid waste collection and hauling from Village of Onoway residences, and accumulation of recyclable materials at their shop location.
- 2. The term of this agreement is to be seven (7) years, with an option to renew of a further three (3) years.
- 3. The Contract is to be forwarded to Alberta Energy and Utilities Board for approval prior to execution as required by Section 45, M.G.A.
- 4. The contract forms Schedule "A" of this bylaw.

This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.
