## TOWN OF ONOWAY By-Law 674-08

## BEING A BYLAW IN THE TOWN OF ONOWAY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH AND/OR REVISE LAND USE, DEVELOPMENT OR SUBDIVISION ADMINISTRATIVE FEES.

**WHEREAS,** under the Authority of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, Section 8 authorizes Councils to pass bylaws to establish fees and licenses;

**AND WHEREAS,** it is felt that the levying of administration fees and charges is desirable in assisting to cover some costs experienced by the municipality in the administration of good government;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Onoway, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows

1. The charge for Development Permits shall be as follows:

\$75.00 for a Sign Permit
\$50.00 for a Demolition Permit
\$50.00 Fence (over six feet)/Miscellaneous Items Permit
\$75.00 for an Addition/Accessory Building Permit
\$100.00 for a Dwelling Residential Permit
\$150.00 for a Commercial/Industrial/Apartment Permit
\$250.00 for a Commercial/Industrial/Apartment Permit (over one (1) million dollars)
\$100.00 for a Home Based Business Permit

- 2. The charge for a Development Appeal shall be **\$150.00** with \$75.00 to be refunded on the recommendation of the Development Appeal Board;
- 3. The charge for a Redistricting or Rezoning of a property or an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw shall be \$250.00 plus any associated costs;
- 4. The application fee for an amendment to the Municipal Development Plan shall be \$250.00 plus any associated costs;
- 5. The charge for a Subdivision Application shall be as follows:

\$400.00 application fee plus \$200.00 per lot
\$100.00 per lot Endorsement Fee
\$200.00 Plan Cancellation/Lot Consolidation

- 6. The charge for an Area Structure Plan (Review and Circulation), including any associated costs, shall be **\$500.00**.
- 7. The charge for a Subdivision Appeal shall be **\$200.00**
- 8. The charge for Compliance Certificates shall be

**\$75.00** for non-urgent requests (48 hours or more notice) and **\$150.00** for urgent requests (requiring response within 24 hours);

- 9. Bylaws 632-05 shall be repealed on date of final passing of this bylaw.
- 10. These rates shall come into full force and effect April 15, 2008.
