

VILLAGE OF ONOWAY

BY-LAW NO 592-02.

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ONOWAY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING A PORTION OF ROADWAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING TITLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, R.S.A., 2000.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel,

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed, and

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Onoway of the Province of Alberta deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to the same, and

AND WHEREAS notice of intention of the Council regarding this proposed bylaw has been sent by regular mail or delivered to all residents in the area;

AND WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by a person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Council of the Village of Onoway in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and creating title to the following described roadways, subject to any rights of access granted by any other legislation:

ALL THAT PORTION OF ONOWAY STREET (51ST AVENUE), AS SHOWN ON PLAN 762 0896 CONTAINED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF PLAN 023 _ _ _ _ AS SURVEYED BY David B. Higgins_ A.L.S. (2003); CONTAINING 0.242 HECTARES. (0.599 ACRES) MORE OR LESS EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS.

And such Road Closures are further delineated on Schedule "A" attached.

This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.
