## TOWN OF ONOWAY By-Law 666-07

Being a bylaw of the Town of Onoway, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of amending bylaw 649-06, a bylaw canceling plans and reverting to the status of a subdivision plan registered as plan 772 0103.

WHEREAS Section 658 of the Municipal Government Act empowers a municipality to cancel a plan of subdivision in whole or in part;

**AND WHEREAS** every person shown on the certificates of title of the land in the plan of subdivision as having an estate or interest in it have consented to the proposed ammendment;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Onoway, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Town of Onoway bylaw 649-06 shall be amended to read "This bylaw shall not be effective unless filed by the applicant in the office of the Registrar within three hundred and sixty five days from the date of third reading."
- 2. That Bylaw 660-07 be rescinded in its entirety upon passing of this bylaw.
- 3. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon being given third and final reading passed.
