**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF
ONOWAY AND LAC STE. ANNE COUNTY REGION.**

Bylaw No. 711A-13 is a bylaw of the Town of Onoway to authorize the adoption of an Intermunicipal Development Plan in accordance with Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act.

WHEREAS, Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, allows two or more Councils to adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan to include those areas of land lying within the boundaries of the Municipalities as they consider necessary;

WHEREAS, the Town of Onoway and Lac Ste. Anne County have jointly prepared an Intermunicipal Development Plan as outlined in Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act.;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 636 of the Municipal Government Act, which outlines that while preparing a Statutory Plan, the municipalities must provide for public input by any persons who may be affected by the Intermunicipal Development Plan, an "open house forum" was held on Thursday, April 24, 2014 within the Town of Onoway;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Onoway has adopted, along with Lac Ste. Anne County, an Intermunicipal Development Plan known as the "Lac Ste Anne County and Town of Onoway Intermunicipal Development Plan";

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Onoway duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Lac Ste Anne County and Town of Onoway Intermunicipal Development Plan".
2. The document entitled the "Lac Ste Anne County and Town of Onoway Intermunicipal Development Plan" attached hereto as Schedule A to this bylaw is hereby adopted as the Lac Ste Anne County and Town of Onoway Intermunicipal Development Plan.
3. The policies contained within the "Lac Ste Anne County and Town of Onoway Intermunicipal Development Plan" shall come into force upon third and final reading by the Councils for both the Town of Onoway and Lac Ste. Anne County.


4. That Bylaw No. 711A-13 comes into full effect upon the date of third and final reading.
