TOWN OF ONOWAY BYLAW NO. 736-17

ELECTION DEPOSIT BY-LAW

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ONOWAY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REQUIRE THAT ALL NOMINATIONS BE ACCOMPANIED BY A DEPOSIT.

WHEREAS, Section 29 of the Local Authorities Election Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter L-21, and amendments thereto provide for the passing of a bylaw to require that every nomination be accompanied by a deposit; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Onoway deems it expedient that a cash deposit be imposed upon candidates submitting nomination papers for the position of Council.

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Town of Onoway in the Province of Alberta duly assembles, enacts as follows:

- 1. That every nomination pursuant to the Local Authorities Election Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter L-21, be accompanied by a deposit.
- 2. That the deposit be in the amount of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.
- 3. That the deposit is to be provided in cash, by certified cheque or money order.
- 4. That the disposition of the deposit be made in accordance with Section 30 of the Local Authorities Election Act.
- 5. That Bylaw 489-96 be rescinded.
- 6. That this Bylaw takes effect on the date of final passing.
