We need to temporarily stop adding fluoride to the water at our E.L. Smith Water Treatment Plant while we undergo construction work. This work will impact several surrounding communities.



We anticipate the interruption to last approximately seven months, beginning September 3, 2019.

What is Fluoride?

Fluoride is a naturally-occurring mineral that exists in fresh water, sea water and soil. Most drinking water contains some natural fluoride. It is known to prevent tooth decay and promote better dental health.

Water fluoridation is the process used in many Canadian communities of adjusting the level of fluoride in the municipal water supply to an optimum level so the community can receive these health benefits.



HOW CAN I MAKE SURE I'M RECEIVING ADEQUATE FLUORIDE DURING THIS TEMPORARY INTERRUPTION?

Alberta Health Services recommends using a fluoridated toothpaste and scheduling your regular dental checkups. They also recommend eating healthy foods that are low in sugar.

The use of fluoride for the prevention of dental cavities is endorsed by over 90 national and international professional health organizations.
